1. Question paper shall be set as per curriculum with the following format and weightage:

- Question Paper shall be set as per curriculum with the **weightage** of 40% (**20 Marks**) for unit no. 1, 2,3 and 60% (**30 Marks**) weightage for unit no. 4, 5,6 with **First** question on **Unit No 1,2,3** and Question No Two, Three, Four on unit no 4,5,6 respectively with maximum four questions.
- The question paper shall contain optional questions with **20% to 30 %** marks of the **total** marks allotted to the question paper.
- Each question bit should be mapped with related **Course Outcome (CO)**.
- Question paper is to be set considering appropriate weightages to **Bloom Taxonomy Levels and Performance Indicator (PI)**.
- Marks shall be indicated on the **right-side** of the sub-question and the questions.
- The question should be set in such a way that it will test the skill of applying the

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knowledge acquired, rather than testing merely book information. The question paper may contain questions based on testing **knowledge, skills and thinking ability**.

8. **Diagrams or sketches**, if any, shall be drawn in black ink or with black ball pen to appropriate question.
9. The questions should be set by keeping all the **students category** in the mind.
10. Depending on the course, the faculty may change the **internal marks** weightage / options of the questions.
11. provide the **model answer** along with question paper and **scheme of marking**, giving distribution of marks for different points in the question, shall be prepared by the paper setter for the guidance of examiners assessing the answer books. In case of numerical problems, solutions of the problems with distribution of marks for different stages shall be given in the scheme of marking.
12. The paper setter shall specifically mention in **instructions** about the use of Charts, Tables, standards/ coded data books/ non programmable calculator etc. The use of which shall be **permitted** during the actual conduct of the examination.
13. The paper-setter must submit a question paper in both soft and hard copy format.
14. In case of any difficulty regarding any matter, the paper setter may report to the COE.
